This 3-day **Leadership, Stewardship & Sustainability** workshop explores the richness and practicality of **stewardship** as a *mental model* at the core of coaching – for the leader, organization, and coach. We'll practice using holistic & integral frameworks, models, and tools to strengthen integrated awareness and responsible actions.

- We'll explore the flow of connections between the leader's (and coach's) interior world and behaviors *within* the broader culture and prevailing systems (socio-economic, political, & ecological).
- We'll strengthen our capacities for global awareness and listening, inquiry, provocation, intuition, & powerful questioning in service to the flourishing of the leader's stewardship of vital resources.
- We'll co-create innovations in coaching that help cultivate in leaders a fully holistic *life cycle perspective* as they develop stewardship capacities and a sustainability focus.

The training design is a mix of experiential learning, assessments, role playing, film, music, modeling, dialogue, small group and large group discussions.
